#### Introduction

To begin, on behalf of the Kenneth and Jacks Families, I would like to welcome you all here this afternoon. My name is Adrian Downey, I am a civil celebrant and I'm here to day to solemnise at this Commitment Ceremony.

Kenneth and Jack are delighted that so many of you are her today, many having travelled great distances, to share this very important moment with them.

Family and friends are important to Kenneth and Jack, which is why it is so important for them to have you here today, as they make their vows - promises of commitment, made in the hearts of two people in love, which lasts a lifetime.

Today we celebrate Jack and Ken's commitment to each other and also their commitment to life to the best that two people can find and bring out in each other and encourage new experiences that that you may not dare try on your own.

In a few minutes, after Kenneth and Jack have made their Vows I will ask them to formalise this ceremony by signing a Certificate. But, by the time I ask them to sign this piece of paper in their hearts and in ours they will have already made their commitment to each other. Because it is not the signature, the scribe on a piece of paper that matters, it is the courage and commitment it takes to stand up in front of people they love and respect and make a promise that will last the rest of your life. It's a pretty big call.

So, don't think you are here today as innocent bystanders, because you have all been asked here, today, to participate. You are here to perform a role far more important than any piece of paper can.
