Introduction

Good afternoon everyone, my name is Adrian Downey and I would like to welcome you all to the naming ceremony of A, the child of B and C. You have all met here today to take part together, in a simple ceremony to celebrate the life of this precious little one and to welcome them into our community.

As one unit, you celebrate your combined joy for the gift of their life, and the acceptance of them into their family, be it immediate or extended, and the acceptance among friends and beyond into the wide world. We celebrate your presence here, as we celebrate those who are no longer with us.

This ceremony will remind B and C that for their lives leading up to now, and for their future, they will be dedicated to caring for their little ones, guiding their development and nurturing their growth as they blossom into amazing people. They wish for you to share in their joy and future on this joyous day, just as they wish for your continued support and love.

The more love and support this child receives, the more they will benefit from life, and the more love in turn they will give to those around them. Similarly, the more people to whom these beloved children relate, the more balanced and fulfilled their life will be. Consequently, your presence at this ceremony is invaluable, as will be your involvement and encouragement in the years ahead.

We reflect on the potential of this child, and the endless opportunities that await them, with this exert by Bryce Courtenay:

"Nature formed you with perfect feet and hands and a heart that beats non-stop, sometimes for a hundred years. You were made complete.

You have inherited a thousand years of wisdom, skill, poetry, song, all the sunrises and sunsets of knowledge past. You are the sum of all the people who went before you.

You are a refinery of all inherited intellectual wealth, the full flood of antecedent wisdom is piped and stored within you – how to climb the highest mountain, slay the biggest monster, how to survive fear and how to summon your own courage and take pride in your wonderful intelligence. Inside you can dream it, you can do it, because the instinctive knowledge of how to succeed is already programmed within you waiting to be turned on, it is waiting to flow like a river as you come on stream."

Acknowledgement of Grandparents

It is not always possible for grandparents to involve themselves in the lives of their grandchildren, but when they do it is a beautiful blessing to all three generations. The important role played by grandparents is the passing on of cultural and moral values to their grandchildren. This role helps them to find identity and security, which aids in their integration into society.

The special relationship of trust which develops between children and their grandparents is something very unique and special. Through this relationship children learn their lineage, family history along with many core values and development skills. For these reasons, B and C wish to recognise and express their gratitude to their parents, for their role in grandchildren's lives. They want to show their love and appreciation for D and E, who are here with us today, as well as F and G who are unable to make it but are here in spirit.

Affirmation by Godparents
